Studying at BBU ISRAEL – Basic Requirements

- You must be officially registered as a student at BBU.
- You must possess a valid passport.
- You must receive an official admission letter from BBU Israel.
- You will be required to apply for a student visa or religious visitor visa through the Israeli embassy.
- BBU will assist you with the necessary documents for visa application.

About BBU Teachers

- BBU teachers are professionally and spiritually qualified individuals from various nations.
- Most are professors, doctors of theology, senior pastors, and experienced lecturers.
- Teaching combines Scripture, academic depth, experience, and spiritual gifts.

Payment for Teachers and Branch Leaders

- All teachers at BBU branches will receive payment after each semester.
- Payment will be based on formal agreements between the branch leadership and the headquarters.
- Branch leaders – such as directors, secretaries, and coordinators – will receive service allowances according to set terms from BBU leadership.

Global BBU Meetings and Conferences

BBU organizes annual international meetings for leaders and teachers from all branches.

- These meetings aim to:
 - Evaluate the university's progress
 - Share knowledge in education and ministry
 - Exchange teaching and leadership strategies
